our Two Coasts' Team offers you our Herdingclinic Level II. Our training methods are based on "Bodylanguage / pressure and release techniques". The Herdingclinic Level I is the foundation for Level II. All herdingbreeds are welcome! Our goal for this clinic is to make you able to analyse your dog's herdingabilities and plan it's individual training. We want to stabilize your dog's foundation and build it up to the next level. Included is one personal coaching of your Bodylanguage on stock. We mainly work on sheep, ducks and geese are also possible if needed. Our property offers different places to train in, like small sortingpens, bigger trainingpens, a roundpen, 2 arenas (speep / ducks) and big fields. For this clinic the roundpens are reserved for your individual training as you are aloud to train parallel by yourself.

We have long time experience in training herdingdogs and their handlers. In addition we are successful in trialing our dogs at international herdingtrials. We see every single dog as an individual and also each team as unique. Our goal is to build up a confident herding dog that is able to lead stock and solve problems as independent as possible.

2. 2 teached lessons with your dog on stock to build up new herding skills

3. Coaching und eigenständiges Training parallel zu 2.

Costs: -first dog 260€

-second dog same handler 160€

-Participation without dog (theorie, "drylandlessons", watching) 85€

-Theorie Evening only 35€

Kids up to 14 years are free.

Food and drinks are included in the clinic fees, except for the dinner on Saturday (optional). If you have special dietary requirements (vegetarian, vegan etc.) please let us know in advance so we can be prepared. **If the Corona-Hygienic-Rules forbid to offer food, please bring your own food. I will let you know close before the clinic starts.**

Applications can only be accepted with a simultaneous money transfer to our bank account. Only this assures a place in the clinic. In case you have to cancel, the clinic fees can only be refunded if done 3 weeks prior to the clinic. You can also send a replacement participant. **If we have to cancel the clinic because of Corona Regulations you get all your money back.**

The number of dogs is restricted to 10 dogs per day. No restrictions on participants without dog.

There are many opportunities to walk your dog close by. Please clean up after your dog. Keep the dogs on leash on our property and make sure they don't bark continuously when waiting for their turn. We want to keep our neighbors happy ☺. All dogs need to be up to date on vaccination and have a valid 3rd party insurance. Owners are liable for all damages their dog does to the stock, other dogs or our property. We treat our livestock with respect and wish you to do the same.

Please bring weather proof clothing and shoes and maybe a camping chair.

Please notice that publishing foto and film material from the clinic in the web is only allowed after checking with us first.

We have enough space for tents and campervans on our property. Other alternatives are:
