# Workshop Descriptions:

## Wheel Pottery:

Wheel Pottery requires a lot of practice and technical skills. I'm super fascinated by it's ruminant effect... diving into this moist clay and let the wheel turn it through your fingers. You might not walk home with a finished cup after this workshop, but you will get the possibility to try something new that might touch your brain and your heart. If you get hooked, there might be more time for you in between, to use our workshop for more practice.

## Fencedogs out of clay:

In this workshop you will build a **clay sculpture after your own dog** (like the ones sitting on our fence line). As the drying process least longer than the festival, I will finish your sculpture for you afterwards.

## Wool Workshop:

“From shearing to wearing”! What to do with your sheep wool? You will learn with Joanna and Wiebke how to sort, wash, comb and spin your raw wool for knitting. If you have a spinning wheel or knitting needles, you are welcome to bring it. We do recommend you to listen as well to the speed talk on Friday about wool recycling.

**ASCANosework Introduction:** Mattias will introduce you into the new **ASCANosework program**. You will learn about the trial rules, different classes and tasks to title your dog in **ASCA**.

**FCI Traditional Stile Herding:** This workshop is split in two parts. Part 1 is about theory. You will get to know all background information (rules, classes, courses,...) from Anna. She is a judge in the FCI Traditional Stile Herding program and is participating with her dog on the highest level representing her country on international trials. This herding program is designed for all herding breeds except for Border Collies (but anyhow fun to join here for them). Part 2 is the practical work on sheep. You will get to know a course and how to work different obstacles. Your dog needs to be able to keep the sheep with you on a big field (Level 2). This course will keep standing for independent training the following days.
